- Doug - Talked to Rollie about presenting pictures that have been refurbished, Rollie not to sure about doing it at the Senior Awards assembly. We received a pledge of \$500 towards the cost of refurbishing the pictures.
- Dee - Not present but told Helene there was no update about the refurbishing of the pictures.
- Bert - Committee suggested we go back to the Spaghetti Feed instead of the tailgate party for the September 23<sup>rd</sup> football game. Darrin suggested Bert have someone check with the Spaghetti Works instead of the Cafeteria staff, he thinks the prices are better. Bert indicated he will have someone check out Darrin's suggestion. Darrin will check with Ty Gorton about serving the football team at 4:00pm and serving everyone else from 5:00pm to 6:30pm.
- Darrin - Will hand out application form for free membership at the Senior Tea.
- Helene - Showed samples of the Golf Tournament Invitation and reported on her discussion with Joe McLaughlin at Mint Valley golf course. The costs to golf will be \$80.00 per person which includes green fees, cart and lunch. The lunch cost is \$10.00 per person but suggested we charge \$15.00 per person for those whom only come for the lunch. She discussed how many people would be required to help on the day of the tournament, 4 will be needed at the registration table, 1 person on the betting hole and 1 person on the Hole-In-One. Her big concern is that we can't afford to put this tournament on unless we get enough hole sponsors.

It was voted on and passed to donate \$200 towards the purchase of team rings for the 25<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the 1981 Girls State Champion Basketball Team.
