Doug plans to send out a mailing that will include the newspaper article about the 'Dream' painting restoration, in the hopes of getting more donations for future projects. Kim and Dee are working on attending several summer class reunions.

New Business:

[1] Darcie received a call from a Ruby Clawson of the American Legion asking if we would make a donation towards replacing the flag pole in the R.A. Long Park at the Civic Center. The old wood pole fell down and the city won't pay to replace it. After discussion it was decided that this is not something in realm of what our goals and mission are, because it is not something that directly benefits the high school or its alumni. It was decided that we would give her a list of potential donors.
