## Old Business:

- [1] Future Projects:
  - a. Water color painting in front entryway. The school has a work order to remove it. Joan will call Dee so she can take it to 'Frame Works' for rematting and new wiring. It may need new glass also, we have suggested it be put in the Library and Joan the librarian says she has room for it.
  - b. Doug talked to Rollie regarding the sound system in the auditorium. Rollie like the idea of us upgrading it, we need to look into the cost.
